ORDER

This matter comes before the Court on remand from the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit. In accordance with the Circuit’s February 10, 2006 Judgment, it is hereby, this 20th day of April, 2006,

ORDERED that this case is **REMANDED** to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives, for further consideration consistent with the Circuit’s February 10, 2006 decision. It is further

ORDERED that the defendant shall submit a status report to the Court and the plaintiffs by July 19, 2006, outlining the efforts it has taken to comply with the Circuit’s mandate. Accordingly, this status report shall identify the laboratory selected by the defendant to perform the testing called for by the Circuit, how long this entity estimates it will take to complete the required analysis, and what additional tasks, if any, the defendant will have to complete to comply with the Circuit’s mandate. It is further.

ORDERED that the status report shall also address the progress that has been made in completing the rulemaking that is already being conducted. It is further.

ORDERED that a status hearing shall be held on July 26, 2006 at 9:00 a.m. in Courtroom 5 at the E. Barrett Prettyman United States Courthouse, 333 Constitution Avenue, N.W. Washington, D.C. 20001.
